Please may I remind you to wear a face covering when entering the school site. KEY MESSAGES

- **Wear a face covering in e.g. shops and on transport, wash your hands, stay 2 metres apart.**
- **If you think you may have the virus, you must stay at home**

Some schools have already sent bubbles of children and staff home to isolate for 14 days, following positive COVID-19 testing.

MORNING DROP OFF

We have had several complaints from parents about the lack of social distancing before the gate is opened in the morning. It is important that the staggered times that we sent are followed, so that this can happen and that face coverings are worn. No child will be marked late when arriving before the gates are closed at 9.10am. Any children arriving after this time are late, and will have to be brought to the gate off St. Joseph's Drive, ring the bell and wait for a member of staff to let them in.
